# RESOLUTION NO. 36 OF 2024 AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR TRAILER STORAGE PAD IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CLARKSTOWN TRANSFER STATION WEST NYACK, NEW YORK RFP NO. 2024-07

**Phillips:** Mr. Executive Director please explain what improvements we are making to the trailer storage pad.

**Damiani:** Yes, Mr. Chairman. Requesting authorization to award RFP-2024-07 in the amount of \$475,850.00 to Colonnelli Bros., Inc. for improvements to the West Nyack Transfer Station trailer storage area. The improvements include the installation of the new concrete trailer landing gear pads, concrete curbs and new dual containment gravity drain system for conveying potential leachate to the sanitary sewer system and a new concrete pad for the reuse and erecting of a 25 foot wide by 35 foot long clearspan fabric structure which was originally installed in 2017 at the Hillburn Materials Recovery Facility and was removed in 2022 during the MRF improvements.
