Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Cereal and Food Boxes, Office Paper, File Folders, Paper Bags & Drink Holders
Cardboard should be broken down & flattened



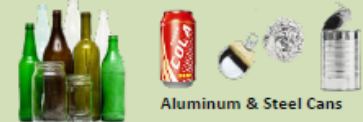
Newspaper, Inserts, Wrapping Paper, Junk Mail, & Paper of all Types and Colors



Paper Egg Cartons



Plastic Bottles, Milk Jugs, Laundry Baskets, Kitchen, Bath and Laundry Containers, Yogurt Cups & 5-Gallon Pails
All Containers should be emptied & rinsed



Aluminum & Steel Cans
Glass Bottles & Jars
Foil & Foil Trays should be rinsed & crushed



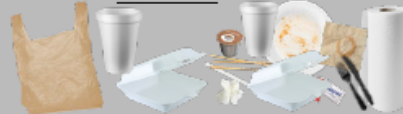
Milk, Juice & Food Cartons

Thank you for your help with Keeping **Rockland Green!**

If your recycling bin(s) contain unacceptable items, **your bin(s) will get an "OOPS!" tag and WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.** The tag will let you know what the unacceptable item is, so that you can avoid that mistake in the future.

Haulers will **ONLY** collect recycling bins that contain items which are listed above on the Recycling Guide. Rockland Green staff will be in various neighborhoods across Rockland County to inspect curbside recycling bins to improve the quality and quantity of recyclable items and check on our recycling progress. No worries if you are doing a great job! You can recognize these staff members by their neon yellow vests and cars with the Rockland Green logo and flashing light.

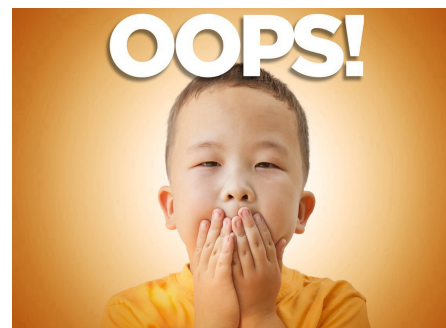


Please **DO NOT** place the following items in your recycling bins:

- Plastic Bags
- Recyclables in Bags
- Dry-Cleaning Bags
- Plastic Wrapping
- Diapers
- Electrical Cords
- Hoses
- Used Paper Towels
- Styrofoam
- Disposable Items
- Food Waste
- Metal/Plastic Hangers
- Batteries
- Medical Waste
- Clothing
- Used Paper Plates

Reminders:

- Batteries/propane tanks should be brought to the HHW Facility.
- Mixed paper and cardboard must be separated from plastic, metal, glass & cartons.
- Expired medication can be brought to the HHW Facility during the 10 weekend drop-off events (contact [Rockland Green](#) for more information).
